



Share Hour Parent Volunteer Program

We are grateful that our school parents take the time to volunteer at our school and parish.

Every year, Christ the King Catholic School requires each school family to complete parent participation hours, also known as "Share Hours". These volunteer Share Hours significantly help offset school and parish costs. The Tuition Contract states that two-parent families must complete 30 hours and single-parent families must complete 15 hours. At least one-half of these hours must be recorded by January 31. The February financial statement will show a charge of \$15 per hour for first half volunteer hours not served or recorded. From February through May, the remaining hours must be completed. The June financial statement will show a charge of \$15 per hour for volunteer hours not served or recorded. However, it is preferred that families give of their time rather than their money as it benefits the entire school and parish community and generates significant goodwill to have involved, participating school volunteer parents.

Each family is responsible for recording their hours. The Share Hour Log is in the School Office. Families may record their share hours in person, or they may e-mail them to the school office at office@ctk.pvt.k12.or.us and they will be recorded in the Share Hour Log.

The gift of parent's time and dedication is an essential part in the success of our school and parish. Participation in our volunteer program helps our teachers and staff to provide a welcome and engaging environment for our children to learn.

All service activities performed at Christ the King School and Parish count as Share Hours.

The following are some examples:

At School helping with: Room Parents, Classrooms, Field Trips, Library, Jog-A-Thon, Auction, Development, School Office, Book Fairs, Jr. Achievement

After School helping with: CYO Sports, School Advisory Council, Student Choir, Parent Community Organization (PCO)

At the Parish helping with: Landscaping, St. Vincent de Paul, Open Arms/Helping Hands, Parish Ushers, Eucharistic Ministers, Choir, Children's Liturgy, Wednesday evening Religious Education
