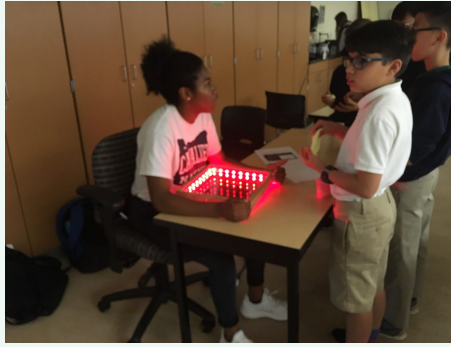


Somewhere in the Middle June 5-9th, 2017
